## SCHOOL FACILITIES

## Works of Art

The state board of education and the state superintendent of public instruction allocates one-half of one percent of any moneys appropriated for state assistance to districts for original construction of any school facility for the acquisition of works of art. The district has the right to waive its use of the appropriation. The selection and commissioning of an artist for, reviewing of design for, execution and placement of, and the acceptance of works of art shall be the responsibility of the Washington State Arts' Commission in consultation with the state superintendent of public instruction and the board. The school board may appoint a representative to be a part of the selection process; reject the results of the selection process; or reject the placement of a completed works of art. Waiver or rejection shall not affect state construction funds available to local school districts.

## Works of Art

RCW 28A.335.210 gives the school district board of directors the right to:

- A. Waive its use of the one-half of one percent of the appropriation for the acquisition of works of art before the selection process by the Washington State Arts Commission;
- B. Appoint a representative to the body established by the Washington State Arts Commission to be part of the selection process with full voting rights;
- C. Reject the results of the selection process;
- D. Reject the placement of a completed work or works of art on school district premises.

Waiver or rejection of any point before or after the selection process shall not cause the loss of or otherwise endanger that portion of the state school construction funds that is not dedicated to the purchase of art.
