Congratulations! The Mary Walker School District has been awarded a Small District Modernization Planning Grant award in the amount of \$10,000 for the following projects:

- Gym modernization

The 2019 State Legislature established \$1.0 million in competitive grant funding for Small District Modernization planning grants (Chapter 413, Laws of 2019, Section 5028). As a reminder, receipt of a planning grant is not a guarantee of project funds.

The planning grant is to be used to create a budget and scope of work using the C-100 form (attached) and update the Building Condition Assessment (BCA) for each of the building system(s) included in your district's project proposal. The BCA assessment(s) will need to be entered in the Information and Condition of Schools (ICOS) system. Districts must submit all required planning documents by e-mail to Scott Black and update ICOS information by close of business on December 5, 2019.

Grant funds will be set up through the Grants Management System. These funds are part of the Legislative capital budget and the district should track expenditures using their capital projects fund.
