 - o 2 items: packet given to board members, and explained the resolution
 - Explained the reason for the budget extension, large grants are part of the reason for the extension.
 - Rural alliance and Discuren grant we are the fiscal agent for these grants.
 - Last year for Rural Alliance to be fiscal agent.
 - 2019-2020 school year budget: budgeting for 455 students (last year budgeted 487)
 - Special ed
 - o Fund balance: estimated low, for the New Year. Need to be conservative
 - We receive a good federal support revenue
 - o Levy revenue
 - Expenditures: explain the pie graph on expenditures by programs. Regular instruction, sped, etc....
 - o Staffing FTE,
 - Fund balances by funds: General fund, ASB, Debt Service, Capital projects, and Transportation
 - Current bond will be paid off, and we will have very little money in the debt service expenditure and revenue.
 - \circ Rick gave a copy of 2 other districts of similar size to show their fund balance to help the board understand.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Curriculum / Text Book Adoptions: Glencoe Physical Science & Springboard Algebra Glencoe science textbook adoption for this year, excited about this curriculum with teacher addition and workbooks, and below the budget for the curriculum adoption budgeted. Mr. Moeller made great recommendation for this curriculum.

RICK: sidewalk project: Edwina received a good grant to repair the sidewalks, now if we don't get these done soon we will not get them done by the start of school. We are recommending that we use the ALL GOAD construction to complete the project, and they can start August 7 or 9. We need one more bid to do the project, would like to start by August 5. Not enough \$\$ to do all project. Jeff, can we go that early?. Question can we take motion to accept the lowest bid: the board will make a motion in the consent agenda to accept the lowest bid given by a licensed and bonded contractor, for the sidewalk project.

Tim Goad: frustration over not getting bids from any contractors from Spokane. Now it is a busy season and cannot get the bid.

KYLE, took over truancy committee and developed truancy procedure. Attendance policy and given to board. Fits with SIP for elementary. Give the board schedules for fall sports and basketball, middle school football will be given later. First AD meeting is September 4 and Dwayne will speak to the remmoval of independent and joining the league. Flip schedule from last year. Can't predict the weather and if other schools want to cancel. Concerns of all league and lack of games.

Truancy in the high school? Middle school is good to go but don't want o do the high school.

MANDY: been in remediation and handed out a copy of proposal. Signed 6 or 7 articles today. Hope to meet somewhere in the middle for the matrix or scattergram. This is the classified proposal at this time. And they are still in mediation with the administration. This takes into consideration of the training for the new requirements. The board was also given a copy of the matrix from two years ago to compare with the new proposal.

Rick stated we want to go into executive session on this issue.
